Abstrakt

The contribution examines the position of Slovakia with regard to the values of the Regional Competitiveness Index published by the European Commission. This index is published every three years, and through the evaluation of individual regions at NUTS II level we can see how the competitiveness of not only regions but also the whole country changes. Such assessment and recognition of its current position is of value to the country, but also to the regions themselves. Through the 11 rated criteria, it helps them identify their strengths, and vice versa, where regions are lagging behind the competition.
