REGIONAL ASPECTS OF SOCIAL EXCLUSION IN THE SLOVAK REPUBLIC

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Abstrakt

Basically, in the developed economies, there are four key types of economic entities: households, enterprises, government and non-profit institutions serving households (ESA 2010). There is an extensive network of relationships between these entities, and their more detailed description depends on the selected criterion of analysis. Following the focus of research, the paper discusses the social situation of households in the Slovak regions, in relation to evolution of government's expenditure on social protection. The poverty and social exclusion might affect significantly the height of public expenditure, and vice versa. The question is, if the effect is the same in the country and at the regional level.
